Introduction

The EMT renders life support to patients at the scene of their injuries or illnesses and prepares these patients for transport to the hospital. The Diploma of Emergency Medical Technician Course (EMT Course) is for those with a background education in the pre-hospital and emergency care disciplines wishing to progress to a Training Qualification UK (TQUK) Endorsed Level 5 academic diploma standard. The program provides students with a firm foundation in the paramedical sciences together with specialist knowledge in the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) operation. It will be taught through face-to-face lectures/tutorials, online tutorials and hands-on practical.

The EMT program is delivered through a combination of classroom instruction didactic and psychomotor. Upon successful completion of the coursework, students are eligible to sit for the United State National Registry's written and practical examinations in Hong Kong.

Upon successful conclusion of this course, students will be proficient in the following areas and eligible for National Registry testing:

1. Airway management including oxygen administration, use of a bag-valve mask on an apneic patient, and airway adjuncts
2. Patient assessments including initial and a focused history for medical and trauma patients
3. Basic life support with use of an AED
4. Spinal immobilization of a seated or supine patient
5. Immobilization of joints and extremities as well as bleeding control and shock etc.

Articulation

Graduates may progress to program of study to Advanced EMT (AEMT) level in the future.

Assessment

Assessment of modules is normally based on a combination of coursework and examination. Coursework can include tutorial exercises, psychomotor and pre-NREMT written test performance.

Mode of Delivery

This program is delivered on a part-time basis. Face to Face tutorial and training with on line blended learning, 90% attendance is required. Normally classes will be held on weekday evenings and/or Saturdays. The medium of instruction is English with Cantonese.

Prerequisites

1. International High school standard or local Hong Kong old F.5 or DSE 6.
2. All students must maintain an American Heart Association Basic Life Support CPR certification through the program.

Award

Upon successful completions of NREMT examinations and licensure requirements, the students will be awarded Training Qualification UK (TQUK) Endorsed Level 5 Diploma and are eligible to sit on the United State National Registry's (NREMT) written and practical examinations in order to gain an international recognized license which is a quotable qualification. All parts of NREMT practical and written exam will be taken place in Hong Kong.

Extra HK\$2000 for TQUK Endorsed Level 5 Diploma**

Target Candidates

1. Ambulance personnel should be actively engaged in their profession and be working for the Fire Service Department in Hong Kong, HKSPMC, Hong Kong Emergency Medical Services Corps (HKEMSC) personnel, Hong Kong St John Ambulance or Hong Kong Auxiliary Medical Service.
2. Members of the Hong Kong Police Force, Hong Kong Fire Service, Government Flying Service, or one of the relevant voluntary agencies (St John, Red Cross, Scout First Aid Team etc.) provided that they are currently working in a field relevant to prehospital or emergency care.

Note that candidates who have not gained their working experience in Hong Kong may be admitted to the course at the discretion of the NREMT Board provided that they have been working in a field relevant to prehospital or emergency care.
